



ENABLING RUNNING CAPTIVE IOC ACTIONS FOR ACTORS

To run Captive IOC Actions, Actors must have Captive IOC enabled.

 Only Network Actors with CentOS as the operating system can be set up to run Captive IOC Actions.

To Enable Captive IOC on an Actor

1. Launch the Director.
2. Select **Environment > Actors**.
3. Locate the Actor that you want to configure, open its Action menu, and click **Edit**.
4. Select **Yes** for **Captive IOC Enabled**.
