

ADD NETWORK ACTOR STATIC ROUTES

Mandiant Security Validation (MSV) Network Actors' network configurations are integral to the platform. If you choose Yes for Validation Platform controlled when running `vsetnet`, Network Actor routing must be configured through the platform.



- These steps only apply to Actors that are installed from a virtual appliance (OVA, AMI, VHD) and only if during installation you chose to have the Security Validation Platform manage networking.
- If you have a software-based install, you must configure static routes manually using operating-system commands; if you don't, MSV may not work properly.

1. Launch the Director.
2. Select **Environment > Actors**.
3. Locate the Actor that needs the route configured and click **more > Edit**.
4. Locate the Routing table and click **Add Route**.
5. Fill out the **Add Actor Route** form:
 - a. Destination host or Network IP address (hostname is not valid)
 - b. Netmask
 - c. Gateway (optional)
 - d. Interface
6. Click **Create Route**. The Actor's Routing table is updated to reflect the new route.
