


## APPLYING NETWORK SETTINGS

Once you have added your DNS and NTP servers, you can configure your Director to use them.

### To apply network settings to the Director

1. Launch the Director.
2. Go to **Settings > Director Settings**.
3. Select **Network**.
4. Complete the Network Settings form.
  - a. Select *the Management IP*.
  - b. If desired, enter your *primary and secondary DNS Servers*.
  - c. If desired, enter *one or more DNS Search Domains*.
  - d. Choose the Director *Time option* you want to use (System Time or NTP Server).
5. Click **Update Network Settings**.
