

VERIFY VIRTUALIZATION

Once you have your Virtual Environment created, you should verify virtualization is enabled and then set up networking.

1. Boot the installed image and open a console to the image through the virtual infrastructure.
2. After the boot, a login prompt is displayed; enter the default operating system username and password (**Validation Platform Credentials** (<https://docs.mandiant.com/home/msv-validation-platform-credentials>)) and update if necessary.
3. Verify Virtualization is enabled by running the following command. If you see inetsim in a running state, virtualization is enabled and you are ready to move to the next step.

```
sudo virsh list
```
