

## MANDIANT-HOSTED CLOUD ACTORS

Mandiant-hosted Cloud Actors (Hosted Actors) can be used for simulations that involve a threat that comes from the public internet. If you have a Hosted Account as part of your license, you can stand up a Hosted Actor and use it as the source of an attack.

For example, when running an Action, you can select the following:

- **Source:** Hosted Actor
- **Destination:** Some actor inside your network

Mandiant provides the elastic IP (EIP) and a fully-qualified domain name (FQDN) that you can then use to register the Hosted Actor to your Director. - Remote Integrations
- Host-CLI commands
- Custom IP tables rules
- SSH access
